Our next Fuse will be held on June 23. Plan to come along, it is such a great evening of fellowship!

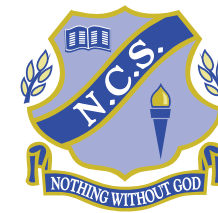
Canteen

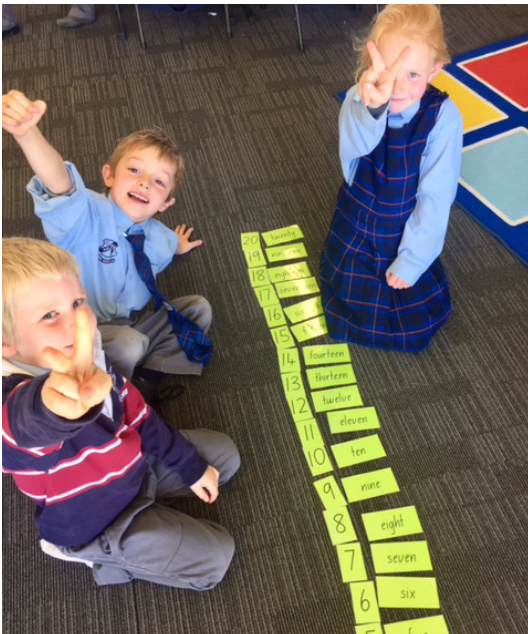
